AT BIELEFELD UNIVERSITY SHE WAS WORKING ALSO AS PERSONAL ASSISTANT TO THE VICE RECTOR FOR INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS AND DIVERSITY (2015-2019). SHE WAS A MEMBER OF THE EXECUTIVE BOARD AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE DAAD (2006-2012) AND WORKED AS A (LEAD) ASSESSOR FOR THE HUMAN RESOURCES STRATEGY FOR RESEARCHERS OF THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION. IN GERMANY SHE HAS WORKED AS AN ASSESSOR FOR THE DAAD, AQAS, ACQUIN, ZEVA, AHPGS AND THE STIFTERVERBAND. SHE HAS GIVEN MORE THAN 50 PRESENTATIONS, TALKS AND INTERVIEWS ESPECIALLY ABOUT REFUGEE RESEARCHERS, BUT ALSO ABOUT INTERNATIONAL RESEARCHERS AND STUDENTS IN MANY COUNTRIES, NUMEROUS UNIVERSITIES, CONGRESSES AND FOR THE PRESS.
